ONLINE STATUS SHEET

At the beginning and ending of each semester it is important to check your online status sheet. The Status Sheet specifically lists the requirements for degree completion. The Status Sheet also shows all classes the student has completed, the respective grade received for each class, and any classes that are currently in-progress. Understanding its usefulness is basic in planning and fulfilling an orderly process of studies.

All first-time students and transfer students entering with a cumulative GPA of 2.3 or lower, or no previous college experience, must contact the AAO prior to registration. Your academic progress will be monitored during the first year with LUTHER RICE.

INDEPENDENT STUDY REQUESTS will primarily be approved in the spring semester only if the course is required for graduation and is not going to be offered during a semester prior to graduation.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT COURSE SEQUENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- **EN1101 is required in the first semester** for all incoming bachelor students who do not have transferable credit.
- **EN1102 is required in the second semester** for all incoming bachelor students who do not have transferable credit.
- **PH1900 is recommended in the first year** for all incoming bachelor students who do not have transferable credit.
- **MP1401 is required in the first year** for all incoming bachelor students.
- **MP4404 is required for all Biblical Counseling minors** and must be **taken in the last year.**
- **MP4403 is required for all other minors** and must be **taken in the last year.**

GENERAL SEQUENCE OF COURSES

Graduate and seminary programs are sequenced according to the recommended order in which you should schedule courses. You are encouraged to reference the full-year course schedule and work with the Academic Advising Department to efficiently plan out your schedule.

For undergraduate programs, there is a required order only if the catalog notes a prerequisite course. You are encouraged to start with the survey courses (for example Old and New Testament Survey or Introduction) if possible. You are also encouraged to reference the full-year course schedule and work with the Academic Advising Office to efficiently plan out your schedule.
